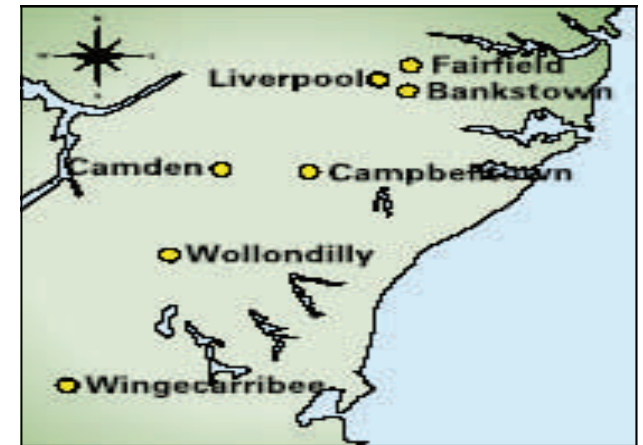

What is the Taxi Voucher Project

The Community Transport Taxi Voucher Project is funded by the State and Federal Governments under the Home and Community Care Program.

What is the Aim of the Taxi Voucher Project?

The aim of the Taxi Voucher Project is to provide an alternative form of subsidized transport for clients.

Who is eligible?

The Frail Aged and Younger People with disabilities who have the ability to access Taxi vehicles.

How often can I get vouchers?

A monthly allocation of vouchers are provided to each client. At the commencement of each month clients may submit their Monthly Order Form



How do You Use the Taxi Vouchers

The Taxi Vouchers can be used in conjunction with cash e.g.

You undertake a taxi trip which costs \$11.00. You may choose to pay the driver with 2 x \$5 vouchers and a \$1 coin.

If the trip costs \$14 and you choose to give the driver 3 x \$5 vouchers there will be no change given.

The Vouchers are not to be used to supplement Taxi Transport Subsidy Scheme docketts.

You may use the Vouchers with any Taxi company in Australia. Usage is not restricted to your local area
